



Summer Youth Internship (Summer 2025)

Westvue Church of Christ—Lewisburg, TN

Overview

The Westvue Church of Christ is seeking a **highly relational and motivated Summer Youth Intern** to serve in our youth ministry program. This position is open to male applicants who will have preferably completed their freshman (first year) of college and provides a hands-on ministry experience working alongside our youth minister, pulpit minister, elders and deacons with oversight of the youth program and church secretary.

Located an **hour south of Nashville, TN and an hour north of Huntsville, AL, directly along interstate 65**, Westvue is an active congregation of **200-250 members** and a great group of **35-40 students**. The internships runs from **May 18th- August (11 weeks)** and is a **paid position (\$500/week) with lodging provided, if needed**. This schedule is flexible based on the applicant's schedule. Youth program-related expenses will be reimbursed. The schedule is adjustable based on the applicant's schedule.

Responsibilities

The **Summer Youth Intern** will play an integral role in fostering spiritual growth and relationships among our students through a variety of activities, service projects and teaching opportunities. Key responsibilities include:

- **Building relationships:** Engage with students and parents in meaningful ways, being proactive in fostering a welcoming environment.
- **Summer Calendar:** Develop a calendar of summer youth group events for June & July.
- **Weekly Activities:** Assist in planning and executing various youth group events and activities. Produce a weekly article covering youth events to be included in the bulletin. Update social media accounts with announcements of upcoming events, pictures of events, etc.
- **Bible Classes & Devotionals:** Teach the Sunday morning middle school class for 5 weeks. Teach the Wednesday night teen class for 6 weeks. Facilitate devotionals.
- **Family Bible School:** Assist with Family Bible School June 1-3.
- **Illinois Day Camp:** Participate and help execute day camp in Dahlgren, Illinois June 15-19,

- **Office Work & Ministry:** Spend morning hours planning activities, preparing devotionals, class lessons or sermons. Spend afternoon and evening hours with students through planned events, mentoring and discipleship.

Qualifications

- We are seeking a **college-aged young man** with a heart for youth ministry, a strong personal faith, and a passion for mentoring and discipleship. Preferred qualifications include:
 - A **strong, active faith in Christ**, and alignment with the beliefs and practices of Churches of Christ
 - **Experience working with young people**, whether through church camp, retreats, or other ministry settings.
 - An **outgoing personality** that engages ALL students
 - A desire to **teach, mentor, and disciple** students in their faith.
 - The ability to **work collaboratively** with ministers, parents, volunteers, and church leadership.
 - **Strong communication and organizational skills**
 - **Reliable transportation**

Compensation & Benefits

- **Salary:** \$500 per week
- **Housing:** Provided in a Westvue member's home if needed
- **Meals & Expenses:** Ministry-related expenses will be covered.
- **Spiritual Growth:** This position provides an opportunity to gain practical ministry experience, grow in leadership skills and impact students' lives.
